Dear Mrs. Grossman:

In May 2013, the Department issued an evaluation of the Westampton Township School District pursuant to the requirements of the Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC), N.J.A.C. 6A:30 et seq. At that time, the district was placed on a continuum in each of the areas evaluated in the district performance review (DPR): instruction and program, fiscal management, operations, personnel and governance.

Following that initial evaluation, the district developed an improvement plan to address applicable indicators in the area of instruction and program; that plan was approved in July 2013. A review of the instruction and program indicators has been conducted using the most recent assessment data. As a result of that review, the instruction and program placement score has been revised. Listed below are the initial and revised placement scores for your district:

DPR Areas	Initial Placement (5/2013)	Revised Placement (12/2013)
Instruction and Program	76%	80%
Fiscal Management	96%	96%
Governance	100%	100%
Operations	100%	100%
Personnel	100%	100%

As noted above, your district has now satisfied at least 80% of the weighted indicators in each of the five areas of the QSAC review process and has been designated as "high performing." Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7A-14, Commissioner Cerf will recommend that the State Board of Education certify your school district as providing a thorough and efficient system of education for a period of three years or until your next QSAC review.
