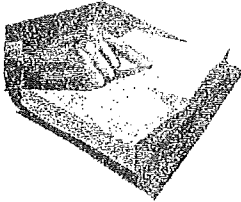

"In The Book" Questions

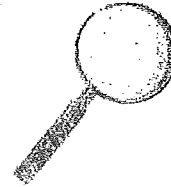
"Right There"



- The answer is in one place in the story.
- You can point right to it.
- The question and the answer may even have the same words.

For example:
 Who is...?
 How many...?
 According to the passage...

"Think and Search"



- The answer is in the story but there will be clues in several places. They may be in different paragraphs or on several pages.
- You need to put together the clues or ideas to answer this question.
- The question and the answer have different wording.

For example:
 The main idea...
 What caused...?
 What is the problem...

"In My Head" Questions

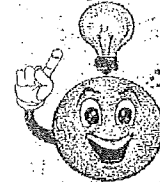
"Author and Me"



- The answer is not in the story.
- You need information about what the author has given you AND what you already know to answer this kind of question.

For example:
 What is the lesson the character learned?
 What was the most surprising part?
 Why did the author...?

"On My Own"



- The answer is not in the story.
- You don't even have to read the book to be able to answer it.
- Use what you know to respond to this kind of question.

For example:
 In your opinion...
 Think about a time...
 Have you ever...?
